



## **317 Main Financial Aid Guidelines**

317 Main strives to make music instruction available to everyone who wants to learn. Through the generosity of community donors, active fundraising, and foundation support, 317 Main strives to make scholarship funds available to qualified applicants. To guide both applicants and 317 Main's review committee through the application process, we have established the following Financial Aid Guidelines. ### **How Do I Apply?**

Complete and drop off your Application for Financial Aid at the front desk during regular business hours, along with a copy of the first page of your most recent 1040 tax return. Applications are due two weeks before the start of the session.

The 317 Main Financial Aid Review Committee will review your application and contact you to let you know if your Application has been approved. After your Application is approved, you will need to register for your class with the Front Desk. You may do so in person or by phone. Balance of payment is due upon registration.

### **What Criteria Are Used To Determine Eligibility?**

The Committee considers the following criteria:

- family need based on income level and family size,

- special circumstances, such as sudden financial change or high musical expenses,
- applicant's commitment to musical instruction,
- availability of funds.

Those applying for financial assistance will be considered on a first come first serve basis, pending availability of scholarship funds.

In most cases, 317 Main offers partial scholarships so as to assist as many families as possible.

## **What Are My Responsibilities?**

Aid should go to those students who are serious about music. Therefore, all students who receive financial aid are expected to maintain 100% attendance at all scheduled lessons and classes. This helps good practice habits and encourages a positive learning experience. Evaluations of student effort, progress and attendance will be reviewed throughout the semester. Poor attendance may disqualify students from the financial aid program.

In addition, all students receiving aid are encouraged to volunteer within the 317 Main community.
