Cancellation Policy: We understand that sometimes parties need to be canceled or re-scheduled. If you need to cancel or reschedule your child's party please give us at least **two weeks notice**. If a party needs to be canceled or rescheduled with less than 2 two weeks notice, there will be a \$50 cancellation fee that may be applied to the balance for the rescheduled party. **No refunds will be given if party is cancelled less than 48 hours prior to scheduled date.**

FAQ's

- You will have the party room for two (2) hours.
- The start time of your party will be the time for guests to arrive.
- You will be able to arrive **15 minutes** prior to your party. (We will have the room set up for you.)
- Cleanup of the room will begin promptly at the end of your two hours.
- Candles, other than on the birthday cake, are strictly prohibited.
- Glitter and confetti are not permitted inside, and balloons are provided by 317 Main.

Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

- Food and Drink are NOT permitted in the music room at any time.
- 317 does not provide refrigeration for party.
- 317 Main is NOT a nut free facility.

Community Conduct

317 Main is a Community Music Center. All visitors deserve respect and the opportunity to enjoy themselves in a fun and peaceful environment. If the community codes are not followed, your group may be asked to leave. All Children must be supervised by a grown-up at all times. Wandering the building is not permitted.
